Long time San Diego HAM Stuart M. Hacken, WV6H, passed away on December 24, 2013 in Midland, Texas. He was only 58 years old. Born May 6, 1955, in Jersey City, N.J., Stuart moved with his family to San Diego California in 1973 where he finished school and began to work in his family owned business, Portrait World. After leaving the family business, he went to work for Western Radio, and in 1979 he started a long career at Motorola. In 2005, he transferred from San Diego to West Texas to further his career as Territory Manager. Stuart's career with Motorola spanned 34 years. His Motorola career was still rising at the time of his death.

Stuart also had many other interests. During his tenure in San Diego he served as a Reserve Deputy for the San Diego County Sheriff's office and worked professionally with several other law enforcement agencies throughout his career. He played bass guitar with a number of bands, in San Diego he played for both The Dynamix and in the Hot House Band. In West Texas, he played bass in the Glove Box Band. Everywhere he went he took "Kronos," his bass guitar, with him.

Stuart was an active member of SANDRA during most of the time he was resident in San Diego. Being generous to a T, he acquired and donated equipment to the organization. He was able to negotiate a Motorola MSR 2000 that SANDRA still has in service, as well as the cable supports on Otay. During his amateur radio career he had five call signs, WN2WFC, WA2BBS, WB6HEE, N6ECl and finally WV6H. The first two being from the New Jersey area and the very first a novice call.

He leaves behind his wife, Kathy, and his son, Ben (both of Gardendale, Texas), two nephews, an aunt, an uncle, several cousins and many friends in Texas and San Diego. He touched everyone with his unique and warm personality. It seems that everybody has a story. Stuart will be sorely missed by all. -{SQ}-


